

Danish Open 2012- A Special welcome to DSISO swimmers 9th -11th March 2012

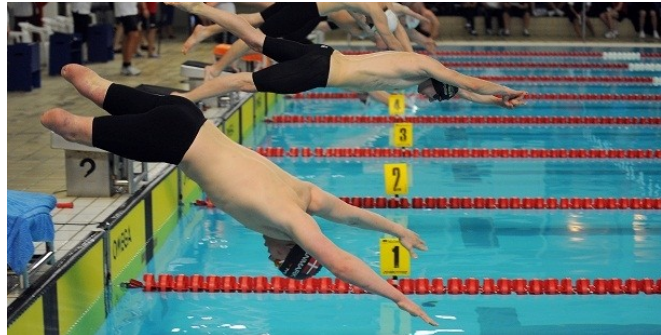
Danish Open is an international, IPC approved event with participants in classes S1-S14 from Denmark and many other countries.

The competition is held in a 50 meter pool with 10 lanes and a water temperature of 26 °C. Furthermore the competition is held with electronic timing system (OMEGA) and complete lane result screen.
